This will apply the new COLA values for Medi-Cal, CalWORKs, Diversion, Immediate Need, CAPI, CalFresh, Nutrition Benefit, Foster Care/AAP/ARC, Kin-GAP, RCA, LA GA/GR and GA/GR Automated Solution programs for the January 2026 benefit month.</p>
