## Important Points

• Review CA-289265 Delink Medical Condition page	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Design Analyst presented and reviewed CA-289265, which involves Delinking the Medical Condition Page from the WTW/REP Program and Work Registration Page.</li><li>• Data Analyst: Reviewed the design requests, noting the WTW/REP Exemptions and Assumptions, description of changes, and the update of the scenarios of the automated section.</li><li>• Disabled Exemption Batch PB00E190 will be turned off.</li><li>• Modify Work Registration Exempt for 11 Months Automated Action batch PB00A277 will look at the WTW Work Registration Page and will include the exemption end date.</li><li>• Disable Medical Condition Exempt for 11 Months Automated Action PB00A278 will be turned off.</li><li>• The change will not impact incapacitated deprivation. No need for a workaround is anticipated.</li><li>• There is no county action needed for current medical exemptions determined by the medical condition page.</li><li>• Welfare-to-Work exemptions will no longer be determined by EDBC. They will be entered via the Work Registration page.</li><li>• There will be no cleanup list or report.</li><li>• There is no opt-out option, as the process is EDBC determined.</li><li>• the written input that was submitted earlier in the week and will provide written responses.</li></ul>
• Diaper Allowance Overpayments (Placer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Placer County explained their concerns about Diaper Allowance Overpayments being created when a case discontinues for no SAR or RE and the diaper payments are issued the following month. If the county is unable to process pending work before the OP is created or if the case is later restored, the overpayment must be cancelled.</li><li>• Hearings are being filed and clients are receiving conflicting notices.</li><li>• Gingko is unaware of a batch job that creates an overpayment for diaper benefits; however, the action may be bundled with another batch.</li><li>• LA shared they created SCR ACA-260325 <a href="#">New Diaper Allowance Overpayment Batch job to create new Recovery Accounts</a> in 2018.</li></ul>
• Cal-OAR Preview Reports feedback (CDSS)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• CDSS submitted several questions regarding the use of Cal-OAR Preview Reports.</li><li>• County responses were mixed with a request from counties to receive the questions to be addressed in written format.</li></ul>
