The functionality in these Quick Guides will be available in the System once FCED goes live, currently scheduled for October 2026.</p> <p>The Quick Guides are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ FCED Navigation ■ FCED E-Data Overview <p>The Quick Guides are now available in the Learning Management System (LMS) and in the Web Portal under Resources > FCED > Readiness Resources.</p> <p>Background</p> <p>The CalSAWS Quick Guides were created to provide users additional training resources to assist them in performing functions in CalSAWS. They include step-by-step instructions as well as screenshots to enhance the learning experience.</p>

Additional Information

The two FCED Quick Guides provide users with functional instructions on how to navigate FCED pages, view information transmitted from the California Automated Response and Engagement System (CARES) and update System pages with electronic data (e-Data) received.

The **FCED Navigation** Quick Guide provides users with information navigating to the new FCED System pages and the purpose of each page. It includes information on what e-Data users can expect to view and actions available. The following topics are included:
