Answer: Currently, there are no new updates on ROI for CBO. ■ Question: Are there any messages in BenefitsCal that let customers know if their application is received after 5:00 or the weekend – it will be received the next business day? Answer: BenefitsCal FAQ – When will I know if you got my application? Provided in the chat, includes the following message, “If you submit your application during regular business hours, we’ll get your application the same day. If after hours, or during the weekend/holiday, we’ll process the next working day.” ■ Question: Service now ticket for bad actors in BenefitsCal, are any other counties having this issue (customer turned in same ID but for two different people)? Answer: BenefitsCal does research and sends anything questionable to Security. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Send tickets with any concerns.

- **Question:** Does BenefitsCal default application date to next day for any applications received after 5:00, on weekends or holidays?
Answer: No, this depends on how the County has set up their e-app office detail – look at job aid “Offices - Manage” on how the fields impact Self-Service Portal.
Answer: This is also determined by how the County has set up their correspondence hours. County receives the exact date/time that the application is submitted. E-app summary – images, has the date/time information. The app date can be updated if needed.
- **Question:** TRUV functionality?
Answer: No information at this time – this Workgroup has not met yet. Tool used to verify earned income when customer cannot access pay stubs – works like Work#.
- **Question:** Accelerated enrollment – gives applicants immediate access to MC benefits – does the eligibility worker still need to review/process/grant?
Answer: Customer dashboard shows if accelerated enrollment is pending or granted.
Answer: Workers still need to review/grant MC in CalSAWS. BenefitsCal sends information to CalSAWS for workers to review.
