Description	<p>Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to provide counties with a list of persons in the process of curing WTW sanctions that must be reviewed to restore their CalWORKs aid effective July 1, 2026.</p> <p>Background SB 119 enacts sanction reforms policies that become effective July 1, 2026. Any sanctioned individual in the process of fulfilling a curing plan when this policy takes effect will be deemed to have indicated a desire to cure their sanction and an intent to participate, and their sanction must be resolved. While a signed WTW plan is not required to cure a sanction, the county must formalize the agreed upon WTW activities and document any necessary supportive services in a written WTW plan as soon as administratively possible.
