In coordination with CR 313671, CalSAWS will update EERCs and verification information for affected non-citizens. Appendix will be updated to provide counties with the hierarchy used by CalHEERS to determine when a more beneficial immigration status is returned through VLP.

If due dates are manually changed, reminders will default to 15 days. Counties raised concerns that only one MC 355 can be sent at a time; therefore, CalSAWS did not add the MC 355 template to the repository. DHCS clarification is needed regarding whether a 90-day due date is appropriate when an MC 355 requests citizenship, income, or other required verifications. Intake processes have not changed. CalSAWS will compile the chat questions and concerns and seek clarification from DHCS.

CalSAWS shared a draft list identifying NQI and PRUCOL populations. The list is not yet complete, and CalSAWS is working with DHCS to identify all affected populations. The list will be updated and shared when available.
