Change Order Number Ten

CALSAWS MAINTENANCE & ENHANCEMENTS (M&E) AGREEMENT (“AGREEMENT”), ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE CALSAWS CONSORTIUM (“CONSORTIUM”), A CALIFORNIA JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY, AND DELOITTE CONSULTING LLP (“CONTRACTOR”) FOR THE PROVISION OF THE CALIFORNIA STATEWIDE AUTOMATED WELFARE SYSTEM (“CALSAWS”).

Pursuant to Subsection 8.2 (Issuance of Change Orders) of Section 8 (Change Orders) in the CalSAWS Maintenance and Enhancements (“M&E”) Agreement, Consortium and Contractor agree to modify the Agreement to include changes that do not materially affect the scope of work, term, payments, or any term or condition of the Agreement except as provided in this Change Order Number Ten. Consortium and Contractor hereby agree to the following modifications to the Agreement:

1. In Section 7.1.3 Change Order Maximum, Consortium has allotted funding that may be used toward future M&E One-Time Services, when the allocation for which is approved by the Consortium Executive Director and Deloitte's Managing Director or their respective designees.
2. This Change Order Number Ten requests One Million Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Six Dollars (\$1,099,986) to be used for additional M&E One-Time Services Charge hours for Work related to H.R. 1 - ABAWD Impacts requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions for this M&E One-Time Services Charge are set forth in Attachment 1 H.R. 1 - ABAWD Impacts Pricing Schedule. M&E One-Time Services Charges related to the H.R. 1 - ABAWD Impacts will be conducted and invoiced on a monthly basis according to the rates and charges in the pricing schedule in an amount not to exceed One Million Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Six Dollars (\$1,099,986).
3. This Change Order Number Ten requests One Million Three Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Four Dollars (\$1,325,224) to be used for additional M&E One-Time Services Charge hours for Work related to Monthly Premiums for UIS Population requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions for this M&E One-Time Services Charge are set forth in Attachment 2 Monthly Premiums for UIS Population Pricing Schedule. M&E One-Time Services Charges related to the Monthly Premiums for UIS Population will be conducted and invoiced on a monthly basis according to the rates and charges in the pricing schedule in an amount not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Four Dollars (\$1,325,224).
4. This Change Order Number Ten requests Four Hundred Seventy Three Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$473,100) to be used for additional M&E One-Time Services Charge hours for Work related to BenefitsCal Income Verification Service requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions for this M&E One-Time Services Charge are set forth in Attachment 3 BenefitsCal Income Verification Service Pricing Schedule. M&E One-Time Services Charges related to the BenefitsCal Income Verification Service will be conducted and invoiced on a monthly basis according to the rates and charges in the pricing schedule in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$473,100).
5. This Change Order Number Ten requests Four Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$430) to be used for additional M&E One-Time Services Charge hours for Work related to H.R. 1 Automation (One Big Beautiful Bill Act) requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and

assumptions for this M&E One-Time Services Charge are set forth in Attachment 4 H.R. 1 Automation (One Big Beautiful Bill Act) Pricing Schedule. M&E One-Time Services Charges related to the H.R. 1 Automation (One Big Beautiful Bill Act) will be conducted and invoiced on a monthly basis according to the rates and charges in the pricing schedule in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$430).

6. This Change Order Number Ten requests Seven Million Three Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Ninety Three Dollars (\$7,353,093) to be used for additional M&E One-Time Services Charge hours for Work related to CFAP Expansion Automation Reappropriation Authority requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions for this M&E One-Time Services Charge are set forth in Attachment 5 CFAP Expansion Automation Reappropriation Authority Pricing Schedule. M&E One-Time Services Charges related to the CFAP Expansion Automation Reappropriation Authority will be conducted and invoiced on a monthly basis according to the rates and charges in the pricing schedule in an amount not to exceed Seven Million Three Hundred Fifty Three Thousand, Ninety Three Dollars (\$7,353,093)
7. This Change Order Number Ten requests Seven Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars (\$749,994) to be used for additional M&E One-Time Services Charge hours for Work related to Reinstatement of Asset Limit Test for Non-MAGI Medi-Cal requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions for this M&E One-Time Services Charge are set forth in Attachment 6 Reinstatement of Asset Limit Test for Non-MAGI Medi-Cal Pricing Schedule. M&E One-Time Services Charges related to the Reinstatement of Asset Limit Test for Non-MAGI Medi-Cal will be conducted and invoiced on a monthly basis according to the rates and charges in the pricing schedule in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Four Dollars (\$749,994).
8. This Change Order Number Ten requests Three Hundred Seventy Four Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars (\$374,999) to be used for additional M&E One-Time Services Charge hours for Work related to County Medical Services Program (CMSP) requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions for this M&E One-Time Services Charge are set forth in Attachment 7 County Medical Services Program (CMSP) Statement of Work (SOW) and Attachment 8 County Medical Services Program (CMSP) Pricing Schedule. M&E One-Time Services Charges related to the County Medical Services Program (CMSP) will be conducted and invoiced on a monthly basis according to the rates and charges in the pricing schedule in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Nine

Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars (\$374,999).

9. Using the County purchase process, the Counties defined in the table below have purchased service directly related to the development and implementation of the CalSAWS System. This Change Order Number Ten requests Three Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Seven Dollars (\$385,487.00) to be used for the following purchase that are funded and approved by the individual County and are incorporated into the CalSAWS M&E:

Subsequent to the approval of this Change Order Number Ten, the balance remaining from the Eighty Million Eight Hundred Forty Two Thousand, Thirty One Dollars (\$80,842,031) in Agreement Paragraph 7.1.3 - Change Order Maximum of approved but unallocated funds for future work to be allocated will be Twenty-Four Million Three Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Forty Seven Dollars and Seventy Six Cents (\$24,349,047.76).
11. The combined total amount of funds for additional M&E One-Time Services requested pursuant to this Change Order is Eleven Million Seven Hundred Sixty Two Thousand Three Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$11,762,313).

This Change Order Number Ten is effective as of July 17, 2026 (the “Effective Date”).

Except as provided in this Change Order Number Ten, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
