Change Order Number One

BENEFITSICAL MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS (“M&O”) SERVICES AGREEMENT (“AGREEMENT”) ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE CALSAWS CONSORTIUM (“CONSORTIUM”), A CALIFORNIA JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY, AND ACCENTURE, LLP (“CONTRACTOR”) FOR THE PROVISION OF ONGOING BENEFITSICAL MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS.

Pursuant to Paragraph 8 (Change Orders) of the Agreement, Consortium and Contractor agree to modify the Agreement to include changes that do not materially affect the scope of work, terms, payments, or any term or condition of the Agreement except as provided in this Change Order Number One. Consortium and Contractor hereby agree to the following modifications to the Agreement:

1. Sub-Paragraph 19.29 (Notices) of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

“Notices.

Except as otherwise permitted herein, any notice or demand or other communication required or permitted to be given under this Agreement or applicable law shall be effective if and only if it is in writing, properly addressed, and either delivered in person, by a recognized courier service, or deposited with the United States Postal Service as first class mail, postage prepaid, to the parties at the following addresses:

Notices shall be effective upon receipt or four (4) business days after mailing, whichever is earlier. The Notice address as provided herein may be changed by Notice given as provided above.”

2. Consortium has allotted funding for Change Allowance up to a Total of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000).
3. This Change Order Number One requests Eight Hundred Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$820,298) to be used for Work related to the ROI – SCERFRA 25-503 BenefitsCal Release of Information to CBO requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions are set forth in the attached Attachment 1 (ROI – SCERFRA 25-503 BenefitsCal Release of Information to CBO). Work related to the ROI – SCERFRA 25-503 BenefitsCal Release of Information to CBO will be conducted and invoiced on a Time and Materials basis in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$820,298).

3.4 Attachment 1 includes Pricing Schedules for ROI – SCERFRA 25-503 BenefitsCal Release of Information to CBO.

4. This Change Order Number One requests One Million Two Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Three Dollars (\$1,243,393) to be used for Work related to the HR1 Medi-Cal Impact requested by the Consortium. The estimated effort, prices, and assumptions are set forth in the attached Attachment 2 (HR1 Medi-Cal Impact). Work related to the HR1 Medi-Cal Impact will be conducted and invoiced on a Time and Materials basis in an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Three Dollars (\$1,243,393).

4.4 Attachment 2 includes Pricing Schedules for HR1 Medi-Cal Impact.

5. The total amount of funds from the Total Change Allowance requested pursuant to this Change Order Number One is Two Million Sixty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$2,063,691).

6. Subsequent to the approval to this Change Order Number One, the balance remaining from the Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000) in Agreement Sub-paragraph 7.1.1 (General) under Sub-Paragraph 7.1 (Total Maximum Contract Sum) of approved but unallocated funds for Change Allowance will be Seventeen Million Nine Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Nine Dollars (\$17,936,309).

This Change Order Number One is effective as of July 17, 2026 (the "Effective Date").

Except as provided in this Change Order Number One, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
