CA-296291	San Joaquin/	<p>Design Doc, section 2.6 describes changes to CW EDBC logic which will ignore existing WTW sanctions and give those individuals "MEM" role status in CW instead of "FRE", while section 2.10 describes a new batch that will identify CW application approvals with individuals with "FRE" status to trigger an automated end dating of their existing WTW sanction.</p> <p>If CW EDBC assigns WTW sanctioned individuals a "MEM" role at CW application approval, then there will never be a "FRE" role for batch to find to trigger an automate end dating of their existing WTW sanction. Please clarify how this proposed functionality change will work.</p> <p>Assuming eligibility staff have already run EDBC in the case in all program mode when approving the CW application from app date through to ongoing benefit months (which is currently the expectation of EW staff when approving a CW application because that program affects all other active programs on the case), is the functionality purpose of batch rerunning EDBC in all program mode again after the WTW sanction is end dated for the sake of properly pending the WTW program? Or something else? I'm not following the reason why all program mode EDBC is required to be rerun again in batch.</p>	<p>Section 2.6 describes the eligibility determination, EDBC will 'ignore' the sanction record and make the eligibility determination for the sanctioned individual by counting them as 'MEM'.</p> <p>Section 2.10 will be revised to clarify that the first batch trigger condition will look for a CW person who has a status of Active with role reason MEM. The reference to FRE will be removed.</p> <p>Section 2.10 will be revised to remove the reference to FRE and add a reference to MEM.</p> <p>The purpose is to safeguard against any unintended consequences of applying the end date to the sanction record. It mirrors a batch some counties are opted into that auto-runs EDBC when a sanction is manually end dated.</p>	Online
