Then can we have a second list of people with the Parolee Type of one year or more at implementation so we can review that the correct Parolee Type is set after this SCR goes in?	Per CIT 0065 26, CalSAWS requested that counties perform a manual EDBC for Parolee Type cases of less than one year, as these were impacting other programs. CalSAWS will provide a list of Parolee Type cases of one year or more, as stated in the CIT. CalSAWS is still working on compiling this list.	Eligibility
CA-295632	San Bernardino/ Region 5	1. The time limit committee has a few questions. SCR CA-295632 Update Time Limit Aid to Apply Child Support from Earliest Unbalanced Month states no county action is needed and a list of cases rebalanced will not be provided. The TL committee would like to request that a list of San Bernardino cases be provided. While the SCR states no county action is needed, it is possible we would need to take action. San Bernardino did not opt to add benefit amounts to C-IV when we converted over in 2004, those dollar amounts from 1/98 through 4/04 are not in CalSAWS. We manually enter aid amounts received from 1/98-4/04 to the time limit aid summary page when we complete a review so CalSAWS child support balancing can occur correctly. Without adding this aid received, child support is being balanced beginning 5/2004, and incorrectly batching child support exemptions. 2. The other question we have is if time limit months with (!) marks or red flags will be updated with child support exemptions during this one time data change? 3. The case is not missing the time on aid months from 1/98-4/04, the case is missing the recoupable aid amounts from 1/98-4/04. So when balancing occurs it does not have the dollar amounts from these months to take into account. I have included screenshots to explain what I mean. The word doc has the CalSAWS summary page which starts the recoupable aid amounts beginning 5/2004 and balancing goes through 7/2007 until the dollar amounts are used. Exemptions would be batched through 7/07, however the customer actually starting received aid 1/98 which are not in the system under recoupable aid amount. My balancing in the excel sheets starts in 1/1998 and goes through 12/1999, so my exemptions would end in 12/99. I have to go in the time limit aid summary and add the dollar amount for each month not in the system for it to balance correctly.	1. If a case is missing time on aid months from 01/1998 to 04/2004, the case will be balanced from the earliest un-balanced month, in this case starting from 05/2004. After Time Limit Aid Summary months are added for the prior months (e.g., 01/1998 to 04/2004), the next time the case is balanced, batch will rebalance all time limit aid months from the earliest unbalanced month, therefore no county action or case list needed. 2. Managers and supervisors both have the CCPSupervisor role in eCCP. My understanding is the role to close the call center in case of an emergency is tied to CalSAWS rights. Could we confirm?	1. Correct, per the design document for SCR CA-265391 – the current CCPSupervisor role/permission will be updated in the backend to now give a read-only access to the eCCP Admin Page. 2. Per the assumptions section of the design document for SCR CA-265391: 1.4 Assumptions - Access rights to CalSAWS pages will not be impacted as part of this change, since only the security group and rights are used in eCCP only. - All access changes will be in eCCP. - Counties will need to add the CCP Admin right in CalSAWS after go live to maintain the same access. CalSAWS CA-265391 Modify eCCP Security rights 4. Users with "CCPMOTDEditor" will only have access to edit the Message of the Day. "CCPAdmin" would need to be added to allow edit access to the Admin page and "CCPSupervisor" would need to be added to allow view-only access to the Admin page. 3. (role is using) renamed to CCPAdmin which grants access to the eCCP Admin page. A new role named CCPMOTDEditor allows access to only modify the message of the day in eCCP. The staff who need access to make corrections to the available features in the Admin Page, including the ability to Emergency Close the call center, should be given the CCPAdmin role/permission.
