

Six-Month Renewals for the MAGI New Adult Group

H.R. 1: Medi-Cal | CA-292582

Beginning January 1, 2027, Medi-Cal renewals for the MAGI New Adult Group (adults ages 19-64) will be processed every six months rather than annually, per H.R. 1. The 26.09 CalSAWS release will change renewal date tracking and management from the program level to the individual level.

Changes to MAGI New Adult Group Renewal Timing



- New applications dated on or after January 1, 2027, must follow the six-month renewal process. Members who already have a renewal scheduled will move to the six-month renewal process beginning with renewals due in March 2027 or later.
- Tribal members, pregnant or postpartum members, children, and individuals in coverage groups other than the MAGI New Adult Group are not subject to this requirement.
- MAGI New Adult Group members will receive automatically generated notices confirming that their Medi-Cal coverage has been renewed for six months and stating their next renewal date.

Individual-level Renewal Tracking and Management



Renewal date tracking and management will move from the program level to the individual level.

- The Case Summary and Medi-Cal Detail pages will be updated to remove the RE Due Month from the program level and instead display the RE Due Month for each individual in the Medi-Cal program, including hyperlinks to the new Medi-Cal RE Month Detail page.
- A new Medi-Cal RE Month Detail page will allow authorized users to view and edit each individual's RE Due Month. When the RE Due Month is edited, the RE Begin Month is automatically recalculated.
- The Medi-Cal Person History, MAGI Person Detail, and MAGI Disposition Detail pages will be updated to display application, renewal, and renewal history details at the individual level instead of the program level.
- When RE is selected at the program level on the Run EDBC page, a new table will display, allowing users to select RE or a Run Reason for each individual. In addition, a new Select RE for All button will be added to select RE for all eligible individuals. Users will receive a hard validation message if RE is selected at the program level and no individual is selected, or if a person enrolled in multiple Medi-Cal programs has inconsistent RE selections.
